Policy for coach, parent and spectator conduct

• Zero Tolerance:

The Villa Grove Rec Program has a zero-tolerance policy regarding alcohol, tobacco, and drug use on all league properties.

Prohibited Items:

Alcohol, tobacco products, and illegal drugs are not permitted in any ballpark or during **ALL** league activity.

• Coaches and Players:

Coaches and players are also prohibited from using alcohol, tobacco, or drugs during practices or games.

• Parent/Fan Conduct:

Parents and fans are also expected to adhere to the zero-tolerance policy and refrain from using alcohol, tobacco, or drugs at Rec Program events.

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Drugs on City Property

All city facilities adhere to a zero tolerance regarding smoking and drinking. It is against city ordinance to participate in these activities at all public areas (all our fields are public areas).

• Coaching Under the Influence

Coaches that show up under the influence of drugs and or alcohol to any games or practices are in violation of our leagues policy and should be reported to the proper administrator.

Spectators under the influence that are being disruptive will be removed.

Profanity

Profanity from coaches and spectators during all games and practices will not be tolerated. The umpire or any staff present has the right to remove all offenders of this rule.

The Rec Program aims to provide a positive experience for players, coaches and fans. Violations of these rules take away the opportunity for kids to grow and have a fun experience with their teammates.

If you see violations of these policies, please report them to the Rec Program Administrative Team so they can take the proper steps to resolve the issue.
